Jock has worked as Race Engineer with many of Motorsport's Top Drivers, including Jacques Villeneuve, Rubens Barrichello, Michael Schumacher & Lewis Hamilton, who he helped to win the 2014 World Championship.

The Race Engineer's job is to use the telemetry data and driver feedback, to improve the performance by adjusting suspension, engine settings, aerodynamics, and other variables, and to help take the driver to the winning spot.
